*Here are some suggestions for simple outfits. The children will need to be able to go outside to play and keep warm as their historical characters!*

**Terry Deary wrote the first of the ‘Horrible Histories’ series of books in 1994 so we are celebrating 25 years of these popular historical information books.**

**Each class has a theme which links to a period of their History learning this year.**

**Here are some of ideas for costumes:**

YR/1 Perilous Pirates – striped shirts/ tops, jeans, eye patch, [No Weapons please!]

Y2 Measly Middle Ages – knights, princesses, castle servants, peasants, lords, ladies.

Y3 Savage Stone Age – animal skins, animal prints, (natural colour leggings!)

Y4 Vicious Vikings / Smashing Saxons- cloaks, hessian gowns / tunics, headgear.

Y5 Groovy Greeks- white togas, tunics, sandals (for inside!), laurel crowns.

Y6 Woeful WW2 / Blitzed Brits- 1940s style, the forces uniforms, Land girls, evacuee children.
