

## Sept 2017-2018 Cawston CE Primary Academy

In July 2017 the outcomes for our Pupil Premium pupils were below pupils nationally. Our provision was effective in meeting the needs of some of our pupils and in raising standards. The attainment of some pupils was affected by illness and special educational needs. Our aim is to improve the outcomes further and to increase the number of pupils making more than expected progress especially in writing and mathematics.

The level of funding is £1,320 per eligible pupil+ £300 per service child.

Our school allocation is £47,820 (pupils). The funding extends to pupils who have been eligible for FSM at any point in the last six years.

We have planned to spend it on identifying effective provision for all FSM pupils, based on Sutton Trust research findings.
