

### Task 1 - English Reading: British Authors

1. Read a book written by a British Author. You should be choosing an age-appropriate whole novel to read.
2. Write book review once you have finished reading the book. Your book review **must** include:
  - book title and author's name
  - what the book is about (plot)
  - if you would recommend it, and why
 You may also choose to include a star rating and an illustration.

### Task 2 - Geography Task: Road Trip around the United Kingdom: mapping

You are planning a road-trip around the UK. You should visit at least 6 different cities and you must try to cover as much of the UK as you can!

- Which cities would you choose to travel to?
- **Draw** an accurate map of the United Kingdom
- **Label** your destinations clearly on the map
- Mark your route from one destination to the next.

### Task 3 - Maths Task: Road Trip around the United Kingdom: distance

You have planned a road-trip around the UK in **Task 2**. *How far will you travel?*

- Calculate the distances you would have to drive, train or cycle in both miles and kilometres
- Your journey will begin in Norwich.
- Work out the **total distance** of your entire trip in miles and kilometres
- Use a table to show this data.

### Task 4 - English and Art Task: Poster Design to Advertise
