Languages

Spanish -Continues

Hindi - Hindi is an Indo-Aryan language. It is one of the official languages of India and the 5th most spoken language. Children will learn basic greetings in Hindi.

Science

Living things and their Habitats

Children will explore a variety of ways to identify, sort, group and classify living things. They will learn how animals are 'vertebrates' or 'invertebrates' and begin to consider the differences between living things within these classifications. They will use and create classification keys to group, identify and name living things from the local habitat and beyond.

PE

'REAL PE' & Cricket

Children are getting creative with 'REAL PE' now and will be making up rules, changing tactics, developing sequences that express their own ideas and fitting these together around a theme.

Geography

North America Project

Children will carry out a geographical project on Canada, Mexico and the United states. They will begin by looking at the environmental regions, the key physical and human characteristics, the countries and major cities. They will also understand geographical similarities and differences through the study of human and physical geography of a region of the United Kingdom and compare this to region with North America.

Maths

Number, Time & Statistics

Children will recap all number work taught throughout the year then move onto decimals, division, time and statistics.

Computing

Animation

Children will learn the basic principles and techniques of simple animation. Beginning with the history of animation, children research some of the early animation techniques used before the use of computers. The lessons then compare a range of animation software and they will incorporate the different techniques learnt into their own animation.

Art & Design

North American Art

This 'North American Art' unit will teach children about how to draw the other half of a famous images, make collage landscapes, create body abstracts, make 'building block' houses, draw patterned skulls and be an artist's model to create quality artwork that shows progression in skills.

The Kingdom of God

When Jesus left, what was the impact of Pentecost? Children will explore the links between the story of the day of Pentecost, give examples of what this means and understand what Christians believe about following God in the world today.
