Geography

Children will be studying their own local area and the landscape of the Norfolk Broads. We will also study the features of the landscape in Kenya and continue on to compare this environment to Norfolk.

The class will research holidays in Kenya and present their own holiday presentation in groups. This will be focused on the wildlife in Kenya, as well as the physical and natural features.

Music

Children will study traditional Swahili music. We will learn some of the language and compose our own songs. We will rehearse and perform these using a variety of instruments.
