

Sept 2019-2020 Cawston CE Primary Academy

In July 2019 the outcomes for our Pupil Premium pupils above disadvantaged pupils in reading, and maths but were below all pupils nationally. Our provision was effective in meeting the needs of some of pupils but others had specific special education needs. Our aim is to improve the outcomes further and to increase the number of pupils making more than expected progress especially in writing.

The level of funding is £1,320 per eligible pupil+ £300 per service child. Our school allocation is £ 27,720 (21pupils). The funding extends to pupils who have been eligible for FSM at any point in the last six years.

For 2019-20 we have planned to spend it on identifying effective provision for all disadvantaged pupils, based on Sutton Trust research findings.
