Languages- Spanish and Italian

Modern pizza originates from Naples when tomato was added to focaccia in the late 18th century. Children will learn some greetings and how to ask for their lunch in Italian and Spanish.

Science

This is the first introduction to studying electricity in Key Stage 2. Children will learn about what electricity is and how it was discovered. They will identify which appliances use electricity in their homes and how to keep themselves safe. Children will construct circuits and investigate how easily different types of switches can break and reconnect the flow of electricity.

English

Our book study is the classic 'Charlotte's Web' by EB White. It is the story of Fern, a little girl who saves a pig on the family farm. Fern's unique friendship with a pig, a spider and other farm animals is woven with fun, laughter and the challenges that farming life brings. Throughout this story, children will have various reading and writing opportunities. They will discuss and debate, articulate a side of an argument, draw inferences about feelings and emotions and discuss words that may capture the readers' interests and imaginations.

Maths

This half term, children will further their knowledge of fractions and decimals. They will then be focusing on multiplication and division both mentally and using formal methods to solve problems.

PE

Swimming takes place every other Thursday. Don't forget hats, goggles (if needed) and to remove earrings for that day. We will be focusing on 'Social' in our Real PE sessions and in Dance children will choreograph a movement to Mamma Mia.

Design & Technology

Children will become Food Technologists and learn the skill of how to make a basic pizza base. They will also learn the principles of seasonality, where and how a variety of ingredients are grown, reared, caught and processed.

Computing

Children will learn how to create websites. Using coding called HTML they will embark on how to design and create every aspects of a fully functioning website.

Geography Italy Study

Children will begin by locating a region in Italy and then compare the physical and human geography with Cawston. They will compare temperature, climate, volcanic & earthquake activity. They will also compare types of settlement and land use, economic activity including the distribution of natural resources.
