What is Anti-Bullying Week?

Anti-Bullying Week is an annual UK event which aims to raise awareness of bullying and to highlight ways of preventing and responding to it. In England, Anti-Bullying Week is organised by the Anti-Bullying Alliance, which is a network of more than 100 member organisations all united against bullying.

What's Happening This Year?

This year the theme is 'Reach Out', which aims to empower children to counter the harm and hurt that bullying causes. Last year, 80% of schools marked Anti-Bullying Week in their calendars, meaning it reached over 7.5 million young people! This was our Odd Socks theme which celebrated differences. This year, Anti-Bullying Week will encourage children to reach out and show others the support they need. This is a busy week in our school calendar but fits well with our value of generosity.
