What is Anti-Bullying Week?

Anti-Bullying Week is an annual UK event which aims to raise awareness of bullying and to highlight ways of preventing and responding to it. In England, Anti-Bullying Week is organised by the Anti-Bullying Alliance, which is a network of more than 100 member organisations all united against bullying.

What's Happening This Year?

This year the theme is '*Reach Out*', which aims to empower children to counter the harm and hurt that bullying causes. Last year, 80% of schools marked Anti-Bullying Week in their calendars, meaning it reached over 7.5 million young people! This was our Odd Socks theme which celebrated differences. This year, Anti-Bullying Week will encourage children to reach out and show others the support they need. This is a busy week in our school calendar but fits well with our value of generosity.
