

Welcome back to this second half of the Spring term where we are celebrating the value of Humility.




**Parking on School Premises**

Please be aware that Norfolk County Council Policy is that there is **NO PARKING** on school property for parents and carers.

This policy has been in place for some time and numerous messages sent via the school newsletter, yet people are continuing to attempt to park on site. The rule is in place as a matter of safety for staff and children.

**The school gates will be locked between 8.30am and 9.15am and at 2.45pm until 3.30pm each day.**
