Key Word	Meaning
1. alliance	An agreement between two or more people, groups or countries to support each other.
2. nationalism	Where a people or country believe that they are the best which can lead to wars with other countries.
3. imperialism	Where a country expands its territories and wealth by taking it from other countries.
4. militarism	Where a country builds up its armed forces to become a stronger country.
5. trenches	A series of lines and defenses dug into the ground.
6. rationing	When food supplies go down, food is shared out more equally.
7. armistice	An agreement by countries to stop fighting.
8. remembrance	The way in which the war and people involved are remembered and celebrated.

1916-Battle of the Somme.

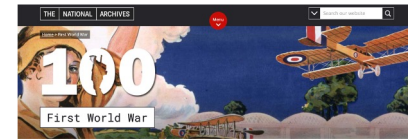
1917-Women's Land Army established.
