

Parent Consultation booking forms have gone out. Please can you complete the form and submit by Monday 4th March. Teachers will get appointment times to you by Friday 8th March.


If you are unable to make these times, please contact the class teacher on ClassDojo to make alternative arrangements. We value these meetings and look forward to welcoming you.
