Plan a boat trip of your own. Where would you sail to? What would you see when you got there? How long would you be gone for?

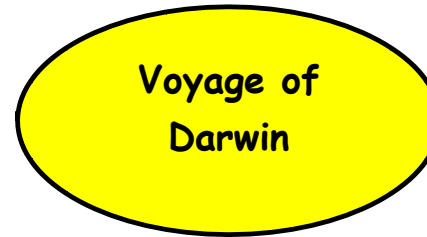
Use the world map given to locate the places and mark the route.

Choose a reading book either from the school library or the library service which has an animal as the main character.

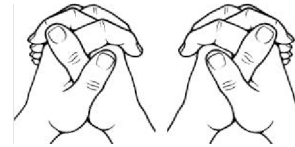
Draw and label the animal using words and phrases from the book. Research facts about the animal and add to the picture.
